<b>UW-Eau Claire</b>	<p>Please tell us about the particular life experiences, perspectives, talents, commitments and/or interests you will bring to our campus. (NOTE: This is an important part of your application for admission. This essay may also be reviewed for admission to the University Honors Program and for scholarship consideration.)</p> <p>If you are an incoming freshman or transfer student and would like to be considered for undergraduate academic and research scholarships and/or University Honors Program admissions, make sure to respond to this essay question:</p> <p>If you had the opportunity to interview any prominent person—living, dead, or fictional—whom would you choose, and why?</p>
<b>UW-Green Bay</b>	<p>Please tell us why you think you are a good fit for UW-Green Bay, and why UW-Green Bay is a good fit for you. You may include personal skills, traits, talents, interests, and experiences that will enrich our campus, as well as aspects of UW-Green Bay that are especially important to you.</p> <p>Please tell us if there are special circumstances or personal challenges that have had an impact on your previous academic record, and that you would like us to take into consideration as we evaluate your admission application. What have you learned from your experience, and how will it influence you as you pursue your college education?</p>
<b>UW-La Crosse</b>	<p>Please tell us about the particular life experiences, talents, commitments and/or interests you will bring specifically to our campus that will enrich our community, and why you are interested in the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse.</p> <p>Tell us about any circumstances that may have had an impact on your academic performance and anything else you would like us to know in making an admission decision, including your academic goals.</p>
<b>UW-Madison</b>	<p>Consider something in your life you think goes unnoticed and write about why it's important to you.</p> <p>Tell us why you decided to apply to the University of Wisconsin-Madison. In addition, share with us the academic, extracurricular, or research opportunities you would take advantage of as a student.
